

# Free Legal Assistance for Child Care Providers



Through volunteers and staff, the Public Law Center provides free legal assistance to existing or potential state licensed family child care providers and child care centers to help them address the variety of legal issues they face.

Some of our services include:

- Helping a provider obtain a conditional use permit or address land use barriers
- Assisting a child care center in starting-up, incorporating, and gaining tax-exempt status
- Reviewing & negotiating commercial or residential leases, employment contracts, and other legal documents
- Representing a provider in landlord/tenant or homeownership disputes
- Helping providers create parent handbooks and other legal policies to limit their legal liability

Our free services are available to both for-profit and non-profit providers located in Orange County who do not have the financial resources to pay for needed legal services. Priority is given to providers that are low-income or serve low-income families.
